


Verse 3 - March 14:


The Son of Man is lifted up, Our eyes behold the sign: You are God's own beloved Son, The source of life divine.

Unless, like grains of wheat, we fall Upon the ground to die, We cannot share the gift of life, Raised up, like you, on high. Lent 150





